



**ASSISTANT PROFESSOR/COMMUNICATIONS
Print/Multimedia Journalism**

The Communications Department at Lewis University is seeking to hire a full-time tenure track position in Print/Multimedia Journalism at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor beginning August 2010. The Communications Department has 110 majors and is growing. The department offers majors in Broadcast Journalism, Print Journalism, Multimedia Journalism, Public Relations, Radio and Television Broadcasting and Communication Studies. The department is responsible for the student newspaper, an online student newspaper, a student radio station and a student television station. The department recently moved into new print and broadcast production facilities. The department's radio station was the first all digital college station in the country and over the last 6 years the department has won over 50 national, regional and statewide journalism awards.

Responsibilities will include:

- Responsible to model the University Mission through dedicated job performance, service excellence to constituencies, respectful collaboration and active support of the University's Mission in Catholic and Lasallian higher education.
- The individual will teach print and multimedia journalism classes, supervise the student print and online student newspaper and participate in journalism competitions.
- The candidate will be expected to participate in convergence initiatives and integrate new and emerging production techniques into the undergraduate curriculum.

Qualifications: A master's degree is required; a Ph.D. is preferred in Journalism, Mass Communication, Digital Media or related area. Professional work experience in News industry would be ideal but not required. The ideal candidate will have experience with desktop publishing and online journalism hardware and software.
